

Video class manners

YOU'RE ON SET

Connecting to class through live video is like being an actor on a movie set. Think of yourself as a film star preparing for a Hollywood performance — here is how to have a good day with the director, the cast, and the crew.

01 GET INTO WARDROBE



Show off your style by wearing your best. It should not disrupt filming, so keep it classy.

02 PREP YOUR PROPS



Device charged? Camera on? Headphones handy?

03 CHECK THE SCENERY



Take note of your surroundings. Stay away from distracting backgrounds.

04 HIT YOUR CUE



Be on set and ready at least five minutes before filming begins.

05 QUIET ON THE SET



Choose a location free of outside noise. Be ready to mute yourself as needed.

06 LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION



Smile, you're on camera. Sit up straight and show that film star face.

07 TIME TO SHINE



Be alert, be engaged, and concentrate on the scene.

08 RESPECT YOUR CASTMATES



Take turns and avoid voicing for others. Save snacking, games, and cooking for later.

09 TRY FOR ONE TAKE



Sign clearly, repeat if asked, and stay on subject.

10 TAKE A BOW



Encourage and support your classmates during the performance.
