20 Ways to Review Verbs in ASL

- 1. Verb Charades Students silently sign verbs while classmates guess the verb.
- 2. **Verb Relay Race** Divide into teams. One student signs a verb, the next uses it in a sentence, etc.
- 3. **ASL Verb Bingo** Use a Bingo card filled with glossed verbs. Teacher signs the verb, and students cover it if it's on their card.
- 4. **Picture Prompt Sentences** Show pictures depicting actions; students must produce a sentence using the correct ASL verb.
- 5. **Match the Verb to the Classifier** Students match specific verbs to appropriate classifiers (e.g., DRIVE with CL:3).
- 6. Two Truths and a Lie Verb Edition Students sign three sentences with verbs. Classmates guess which is the lie.
- 7. **Verb Tense Swap** Give students a verb; they must sign it in present, past, and future tenses using NMMs and time indicators.
- 8. **Verb vs. Noun** Students distinguish and sign the verb form and noun form of similar pairs (e.g., FLY vs. AIRPLANE).
- 9. Role-Play Scenarios Give students a setting (e.g., doctor's office), and they role-play using appropriate verbs.
- 10. **Verb Memory Game** Create cards with pictures and glossed verbs. Students must match picture to the correct verb.
- 11. Create a Story Using Verbs Provide a list of verbs. Students create a visual story incorporating at least 5 of them.
- 12. Expressive Re-Telling Show a short clip (no sound). Students re-tell what happened using correct verbs.
- 13. **Verb Categorization Challenge** Sort verbs into categories: directional, non-directional, stative, plain, etc.
- 14. Sign-Along to Silent Skits Students create short silent skits focusing on action. Audience

identifies the verbs used.

- 15. **ASL Verb Hot Seat** One student sits with their back to the screen; others sign the verb displayed for the student to guess.
- 16. **Peer Teaching Pair students**. One teaches the other 3 verbs with example sentences and then switches.
- 17. **Verb Conjugation Chart in ASL** Have students create a chart using NMMs for tense with a verb in three contexts.
- 18. Receptive Quiz Teacher signs a verb. Students write or select its gloss or meaning.
- 19. 'Would You Rather' Verb Edition Pose 'Would you rather...' questions with two verbs. Students answer in ASL and explain why.
- 20. Flipgrid or Video Review Students record short videos of themselves using assigned verbs in full ASL sentences.
