### Identity

#### 1. Deaf Role Models

Research and present on a Deaf role model in a creative format.

#### 2. Cultural Iceberg

Create a visual showing visible vs. invisible aspects of Deaf culture.

#### 3. Name Sign Exploration

Interview 3 Deaf individuals and compare how they received their name signs.

#### 4. Deaf Community Poster

Create an informative poster about what it means to be part of the Deaf community.

#### 5. Deaf or Hard of Hearing?

Explore and discuss the difference in identity between Deaf and HoH individuals.

### Accessibility

#### 6. Accessibility Scavenger Hunt

Find and document 5 accessibility features in your school or community.

#### 7. Technology for the Deaf

Research and demonstrate a Deaf technology such as videophones or flashing alarms.

#### 8. ASL and Emergency Alerts

Evaluate how well emergency alerts serve the Deaf community.

#### 9. Barriers to Communication

Role-play situations involving communication barriers and brainstorm solutions.

#### 10. Interpreters in Media

Identify and discuss use of interpreters in televised events.

#### 11. Gallaudet University Virtual Tour

Explore Gallaudet's history through its website or a virtual tour.

#### 12. History of Sign Language Laws

Create a timeline of important U.S. legislation affecting the Deaf.

#### 13. Milan Conference Impact

Watch a video or read an article about the Milan Conference and write a reflection.
