Expressive Exit Ticket Prompts

- Sign one new vocabulary word you learned today.
- Demonstrate a classifier you used in class today and show its meaning.
- Retell one thing that happened in class using ASL.
- Sign your answer to this question: What was your favorite part of the lesson?
- Use facial expressions to show a feeling or emotion from today's topic.
- Fingerspell a new sign you want to remember.
- Sign a short sentence using a directional verb.
- Act out a classroom rule or concept in ASL.
- Describe your favorite sign from today and why.
- Sign one WH-question and answer it yourself.

Receptive Exit Ticket Prompts

- Watch your teacher sign a sentence and write down what it meant.
- Watch a classmate sign something and guess what they said.
- Identify the handshape or parameter used in a signed word.
- Write down the meaning of a classifier used in a signed sentence.
- Circle or check the correct meaning of a signed phrase shown on video.
- Answer a multiple choice question based on a short signed story.
- Watch a signed sentence and identify the non-manual marker used.
- Match the signed vocabulary to its English word.
- List three signs you recognized during today's review.
- Watch a fingerspelled word and write it down correctly.
