ASL Pronoun Lesson (20 Words)

Teacher Guide

Objective

Students will recognize, produce, and use ASL pronouns in context through space, pointing, and interactive activities.

1. Warm-Up: Point to Who? (5 minutes)

- Teacher signs "YOU" → student replies "ME."
- Teacher signs "HE/SHE" (points to a student) → class answers with correct pronoun.

2. Guided Practice: Space Setup (10 minutes)

- Assign space: right = SHE, left = HE, front = THEY.
- Model sentences: "I HELP HER" / "HE HELP ME."
- Students copy, then pair practice with role switching.

3. Independent Practice: Pronoun Relay (10 minutes)

- Cards with pronouns (I, YOU, HE, SHE, WE, THEY, etc.).
- Student draws a card → makes a sentence.
- Teacher/peers give quick feedback.

4. Game: Guess Who? (10 minutes)

- Student signs "SHE LOVE PIZZA" \rightarrow points to space.
- Class guesses who "she" is.
- Rotate through all pronouns.

5. Closing: Story Chain (5 minutes)

- Teacher begins: "I SEE YOU."
- Students add on: "YOU SEE HIM." \rightarrow "HE HELP THEM."
- Continue until all pronouns are used.

Teacher Tips

■ Reinforce consistent pointing and eye gaze.

- \blacksquare Use role-shift often (I tell you / You tell me).
- Connect each activity to the 20 pronouns in ASLdeafined.

Warm-Up

- If teacher signs YOU → answer ME.
- If teacher signs HE/SHE \rightarrow point to the right person.

Practice

1. Space Setup

- Right = SHE | Left = HE | Front = THEY
- Try: "I HELP HER" / "HE HELP ME."

2. Pronoun Relay

- Draw a pronoun card.
- Make a sentence with it.

3. Guess Who?

- Sign a pronoun and sentence (Ex: "SHE EAT APPLE").
- Class guesses who you mean.

4. Story Chain

- Add on: "I SEE YOU" \rightarrow "YOU SEE HIM" \rightarrow "HE HELP THEM."
- Remember: In ASL, pronouns = pointing!
