

Sample 1-Week Lesson Plan: ASL Verb Practice

This sample lesson plan demonstrates how to teach a 20-verb lesson from ASLdeafined.com in one week. It includes warm-ups, activities, contextual practice, and assessments to help students engage with and retain the material.

Day	Focus	Activities
Day 1	Introduction & Chunking	Introduce 5–7 verbs by category. Use demonstration + repetition. Quick 'Verb Charades' to reinforce.
Day 2	Context Practice	Pair work: create short skits using verbs. Scenario cards for group practice (e.g., 'late to school').
Day 3	Directionality & Pronouns	Practice directional verbs with partners (I GIVE YOU, YOU HELP ME). Play 'Verb Toss' across the room.
Day 4	Expressive Practice	Students sign a 1-minute video journal using at least 5 verbs. Exit Ticket: each student signs one verb sentence before leaving.
Day 5	Review & Assessment	Spiral review of all 20 verbs. Flash Verb Battles + peer-assessed mini-skits. Short quiz: sign 5 verbs in sentences.

■ This plan balances introduction, practice, and review to help students retain all 20 verbs. It can be adapted for different class lengths and student levels.
