# ASL Classifier Teaching Roadmap

<b>Level 1 Introduction</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What classifiers are</li><li>• Handshape • Movement • Location</li><li>• Recognize basic classifiers</li></ul> <p>Focus: CL:1, CL:3, CL:B, CL:5</p>
<b>Level 2 Basic Use</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use common classifier handshapes</li><li>• Show movement with classifiers</li><li>• Use space to show location</li></ul> <p>Example: person walking, car driving</p>
<b>Level 3 Combining Classifiers</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Combine multiple classifiers</li><li>• Maintain consistent handshapes</li><li>• Describe interactions between objects</li></ul> <p>Example: car passing another car</p>
<b>Level 4 Classifier Storytelling</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Describe events with classifiers</li><li>• Use visual perspective</li><li>• Create detailed scenes</li></ul> <p>Example: describing accidents or environments</p>
<b>Level 5 Advanced Use</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Complex classifier sequences</li><li>• Spatial mapping</li><li>• Fluent storytelling</li></ul> <p>Example: complex narratives and conversations</p>
